Eligibility Criteria

In order to be eligible to apply for the Pediatric Residency training program, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Graduated no more than 5 years from the application date
- 2. Hold a valid Medical License or be eligible for licensure in Qatar
- 3. Meet the minimum accepted clinical and English Exams' scores

Updated CV

Letter of Intent/ Personal Statement

A Letter of Intent or Personal Statement is a letter expressing your interest in joining the Pediatric Residency Program. The letter should highlight your strengths and experience, to showcase your application to the interview panel.

Medical Degree

This document must be provided in the English language. If the original document is in another language, it must be officially translated into English and uploaded as a single file with the original language document.

Medical School Transcript

This document must be provided in the English language. If the original document is in another language, it must be officially translated into English and uploaded as a single file with the original language document.

• Internship Certificate

Applicants meeting the following criteria are exempted from providing an internship certificate:

- Graduates of Weill Cornell Medicine Qatar
- o Graduates of Qatar University College of Medicine

Applicants currently completing their internship should provide evidence of the expected internship program completion date and details of rotations undertaken, including their duration.

This document must be provided in the English language. If the original document is in another language, it must be officially translated into English and uploaded as a single file with the original language document.

• Passport Copy

Passport must be valid at the time of application

• Letters of Recommendation
